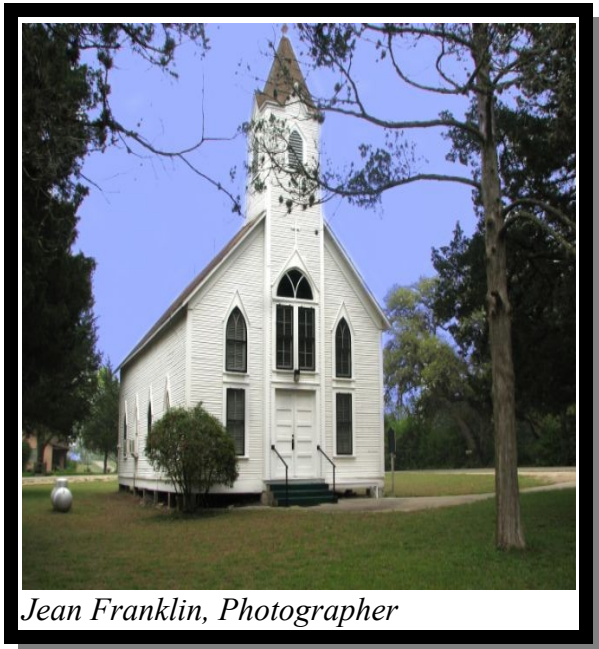
Moderators of this SIG are: **Ben Anthony**, a fundamental investor, and **James Hug**, a technical trader.
